#### Welcome to the joint research meeting for Architecture in Effect, Architecture in the Making, and ResArc Chalmers Architecture, April 10-11, 2014

The main idea with the symposium is to increase contact between researchers engaged in the two strong research environments (SREs) Architecture in Effect and Architecture in the Making, as well as within ResArc. It provides an opportunity for PhD students to meet with senior researchers, and is a forum in which we all can present and discuss finished, ongoing and new projects, future ideas and possible new themes in the development of architectural theory and methods.

The meeting is intended as mainly internal, also involving members of our advisory groups. The setting is informal and the structure kept simple, in five interlinked formats:

- Overview quick, short, pecha kucha-style presentations (mandatory)
- Focus in depth discussions in smaller groups (optional)
- Crossover panel debates where 2-3 themes are confronted and discussed 'transversally' (in further selection)
- State of the Arts concluding discussion on where we are (plenary)
- Poster any format, but basically no technical support provided (optional)

Each environment contains four subthemes. In Architecture in Effect these are: Critical Historiography, Material Conditions, Critical Projections, and Architects in Formation; and in Architecture in Making they are: History, Material Making, Investigative Modelling, and Alterations. These allow for several interconnections to be made in theory & methodology development. However, we will not stress this as a thematic matrix but rather let the programme evolve from the participants projects.
